Set TextQuick to your right soft key on your standby screen, that way it will be even faster to send messages to your favourite people!

TextQuick

Do you know who your text buddies really are? Want a quick way to find friends in your address book? Want to make your phone easier to use? Then TextQuick is for you. TextQuick presents you with a list of your contacts sorted in popularity order. TextQuick sorts your contacts based on the number of text messages you have sent and received between each other. With one click you can quickly start composing a text or start a call. Simple, fast, easy.

Using TextQuick

When TextQuick starts for the first time it works out who you text the most, by scanning through all your text messages, both those you've sent and those messages you've received. Depending on how many messages you have in your inbox this could take a minute or so. But don't worry it saves all this information so that next time you start TextQuick it will be up and running in about two seconds. TextQuick updates its list of who it thinks are your most popular text friends every time you start it. If you've not used TextQuick in a while it might take it a second or two to check its list.

TextQuick's Main Screen



TextQuick's main screen looks almost like your standard phone book, however you should notice that the people you text the most are now listed at the top of the list.

Text Someone

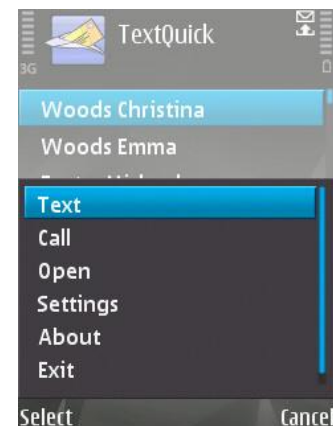
To text someone simply press the fire or select button on your phone, or on touch devices simply tap the contact and TextQuick will launch an SMS composer window already pre-populated with your contact's details. You can perform the same function by selecting "Options" -> "Text" from the menu.

Call Someone

TextQuick also allows you to call your most popular contacts. The fastest way to do this is to simply press the green "call" key on your phone (if you have one). When you do, TextQuick will automatically dial that person. You can also use the TextQuick menu; simply select "Options" -> "Call".

Open a Contact

You can "Open" a contact – jump to your contact in the address book. This is really easy and straight forward, simply select "menu" -> "open". This is incredibly useful when you are trying to find a contact's telephone number, or even update their details – you no longer need to hunt them down in the standard address book.



Settings

TextQuick allows you to customise not only how it displays the names from your address book, but also how TextQuick behaves after sending a message. To access the settings screen select "Options"->"Settings" from the menu.

After Sending Message

After sending a text message you can request that TextQuick does one of three things:

Return to TextQuick

This is the standard behaviour, after sending a text message the phone will return you to TextQuick.

Quit TextQuick

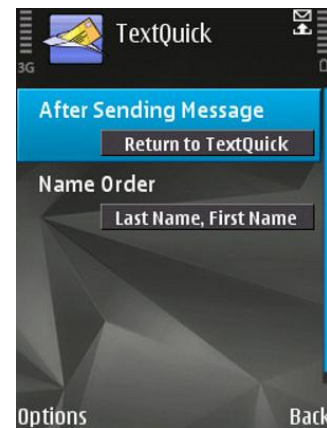
If you select this behaviour, after sending a text message TextQuick will quit. If you start TextQuick from your standby (home) screen then after you've sent your text message the phone will return you back to the standby screen. This is really useful for quickly applying the key lock to your phone, using the left soft & "*" key press. Since TextQuick automatically quits, the next time you want to use it TextQuick will have to reload the list of your favourite people. If you use TextQuick frequently the small delay in loading this information can be inconvenient. An alternative is to send TextQuick to the background.

TextQuick to background

This option keeps TextQuick running in the background. After you send a text message TextQuick will set it's self as a background application on your phone. Like the previous option if you start TextQuick from your standby (home) screen then after you've sent your text message the phone will return you back to the standby screen. This can be really convenient for people who send a lot of text messages; by returning you to the standby screen you can quickly apply the key lock. In addition because TextQuick is kept running in the background getting to TextQuick the next time you want to use it will be as quick as possible. When you select this option TextQuick changes its main menu from "Options, Exit" to "Options, Back". This makes it even easy for you to keep TextQuick running in the background.

Name Order

In addition the "Settings" screen allows you to change the order with which names are displayed. Under the "Name Order" there is now a choice of the default "Last Name, First Name" or "First Name, Last Name".



Known Limitation on Symbian^3 devices: Unlike on S60 5th Edition devices selecting a setting option and pressing with your finger will not allow you to change the value. You must select "Options"->"Change" from the menu to change the settings value. This is a known limitation of the current build of TextQuick.

Features

- Sorts contacts in your address book by text message popularity
- Provides single click texting and "green" call key access allowing you to access your contacts quickly and easily
- Only displays contacts with mobile phone numbers

Limitations

- Contacts with no personal name, for instance address book entries with just a company name are displayed as "Unnamed(telephone-number)"
- Doesn't display contacts which do not contain a **mobile** telephone number
- Does not rank contacts based on email usage information
- Does not rank contacts based on call log information
- Only updates the list and list order when the application is restarted
 - No run time watching of the address book / contacts book

Known Issues

- **Settings Screen on Symbian^3 Devices**
Unlike on S60 5th Edition devices selecting a setting option and pressing with your finger will not allow you to change the value. You must select "Options"->"Change" from the menu to change the settings value. This is a known limitation of the current build of TextQuick, it only affects Symbian^3 devices.
- **Updating Contact Names**
If you change a contacts name it will only update in TextQuick after the application is exited and restarted
